

esus revises the law given to Moses and the Israelites at Mount Sinai. This law was central to Jewish identity. Jewish teachers were critiqued on how well they knew and upheld it. Jesus knows that his fellow Jews will be shocked that he edits God's law, so first he explains his relationship to it. Jesus wants his disciples to do an even better job of following God's law than their religious leaders.

SCRIPTURE READINGS FOR MASS THIS SUNDAY

LEVITICUS To understand today's readings we have to understand what it means to be holy for are we to imitate God's holiness. The Hebrew word for holiness means to be other, to be different. This reading tells us how to to be holy/different from the way people normally act.

St Paul is continuing this contrast between the worldly wisdom of philosophers with the secret wisdom of God that Paul's imparting here.

MATTHEW Jesus takes the teaching of Leviticus we heard in today's first reading that we are to be different and intensifies it.

WELCOME to baby Sophie Buchanan who will be baptised into God's family this Sunday. May her parents be not only the first but the best of teachers in the ways of faith.


