To Help with the running costs of the Parish, I would like to ask all who PAY TAX (on INCOME OR SAVINGS) to join our gift aid scheme, as this will provide the Parish with an additional 25p for every pound donated.

### How does Gift Aid work?

The following example may help you:

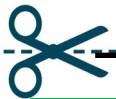
The Tax paying parishioner donates £5 into the weekly collection The Parish receive £5, then with Gift Aid added, the £5.00 donation becomes £6.25 which is an increase of £1.25, (i.e. 25p per £1 donated). So if you donated £5 per week throughout the year you would have donated £260, with Gift Aid added this yearly amount increases to £325 which is a yearly increase of £65.

St. Francis Xavier Parish at present is missing out on this

much needed financial support since many of our parishioners are not registered to St. Francis Xavier Parish Gift Aid Scheme.

I would be grateful if you are not registered to the Gift Aid Scheme, that you fill out a form and **return it via the collection basket**. To make things easier, a GiftAid form is included with this post. You can simply download it, complete it, sign it and put it through the chapel house letterbox. You would then be issued with a numbered envelope If using the weekly envelope might be inconvenient, you can always make your weekly donation via a monthly standing order (*once again, I have posted such a form below*). You simply fill this in and take it to **YOUR** bank. **Thereafter, you need do no more. I thank all parishioners for your support.**
