PREPARING FOR MASS WHAT IS GOD SAYING TO US TODAY?



FIRST READING In spite of having experienced God's help in various ways, the liberated slaves complain bitterly against Moses, God's spokesman. Here they are complaining about lack of water. Despite their ingratitude, God shows his care for his people by providing water for them in the desert. This prepares us for the Gospel, and the 'living water' God offers us through Jesus.

SECOND READING St Paul says that God has proved his extraordinary love for us by the fact that Christ died for us *while we were still sinners.*

GOSPEL tells the story of Jesus' encounter with a Samaritan woman. As the Israelites journeyed through the desert, Moses provided them with the life-saving gift of ordinary water (*First Reading*). Jesus, the new Moses, offers us something infinitely better. He offers us 'living water', that is, a share in the very life of God. It is through the waters of Baptism that we receive a share in the life of God.

BISHOP TOAL ON THE CORONAVIRUS

Bishop Toal has decided that, in addition to the precautions we have in place to protect against the possible spread of the Coronavirus, we need to consider an alternative method of collecting the offertory and other special collections.

From this weekend, the offertory collection will be taken up as a RETIRAL collection for parishioners to place their offertory collections in a collection basket as they leave the church.
